Who Are We?

The Bermuda Constituency Boundaries Commission (BCBC) is a commission appointed by Her Excellency the Governor to assess the state of the Constituency Boundaries in Bermuda. The Commission is comprised of two representatives from each political party and two independent members, who serve as the chairman and the judicial member.

What is our mandate?

The Bermuda Constituency Boundaries Commission has begun its assessment of the 36 constituencies into which Bermuda is divided for the purposes of voting in parliamentary elections. The Commission ensures that each constituency, as far as is reasonably practicable, contains an equal number of persons qualified to be registered as electors.

We are working together.

The Bermuda Constituency Boundaries Commissioners are working together to ensure that the constituency boundaries are fairly divided, taking no account of the racial distribution of electors within Bermuda and carefully considering geographical features and natural boundaries within Bermuda. The Commission is working together to ensure equal vote of equal value for all voters.
